### **Snorkel Safari/Glass Bottom Boat Tour**

Held four times daily is an hour long educational snorkel tour of one of our beautiful local reef sites. Opt to hop in for a snorkel with a guide or stay onboard to watch through the glass viewing windows. A trip full of healthy coral and a lot of different colourful fish.

### **Certified Dive**

Held three times daily, for those who hold a scuba diving license. We have a great variety of different dive sites in and on the outskirts of Natadola Bay. Topography varies from sloping reefs, small overhangs/walls to sites with a sandy bottom and big coral bommies. On a usual day we see beautiful coral and plenty of fish. On a great day we can see turtles, reef sharks and eagle rays.

### **Pool Splash**

Ever wondered what it would feel like to breathe underwater? Well wonder no more! Sign up for a pool splash (held twice daily) and try scuba diving in our designated dive pool. One of our fully qualified SSI Instructors (Scuba Schools International) will give a briefing and show you some basic skills to introduce you to the underwater world.

If you love it you can then book on an Introductory Dive. Held four times daily, it is a wonderful experience to go and explore the ocean for the first time with scuba equipment.

### **Coral Gardening**

A way for you to give back to the ocean, coral gardening is designed to help introduce you to how we are encouraging regrowth of the coral reef. We collect broken fragments of coral and replant them on frames until they can be moved back onto the reef to blossom! All this takes place during the Snorkel Safari with one of our onsite Marine Biologists.

### **Surfing**

Want to learn how to surf? We offer surf lessons here during the hours of high tide. A great way to get you started so that you can continue to practice during the rest of your vacation.
